5LB Grits, Sugar, Dried Beans/Peas, Canned Fruit, Jelly Canned Potatoes and Peanut Butter (Food Pantry)

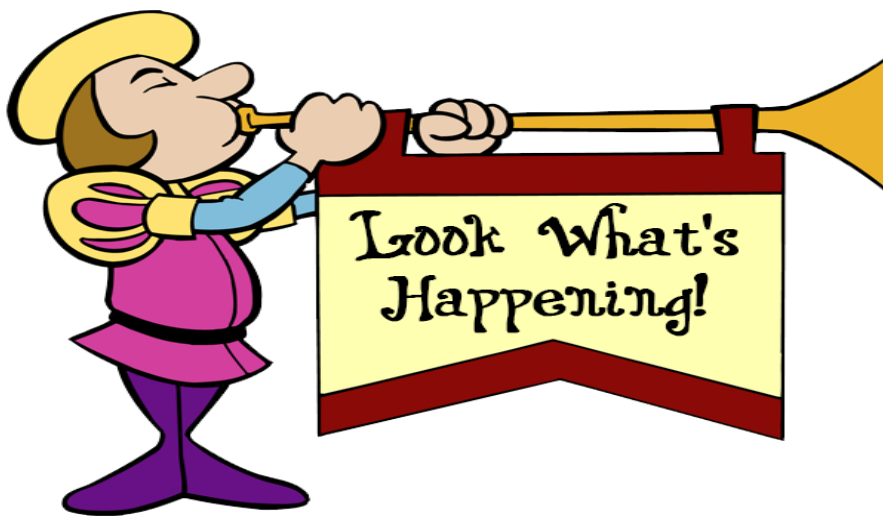

6:30PM in the Fellowship Hall

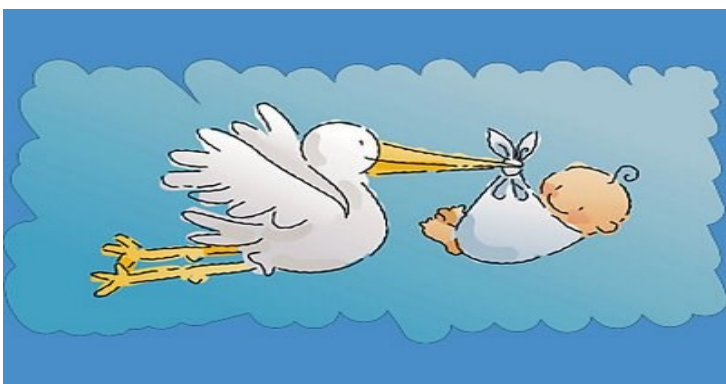
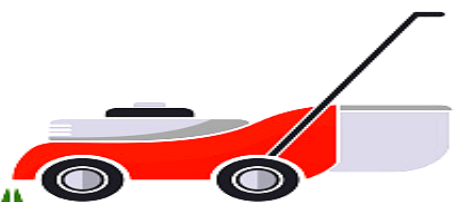
Come and join us June 14th, 21st and 28th.

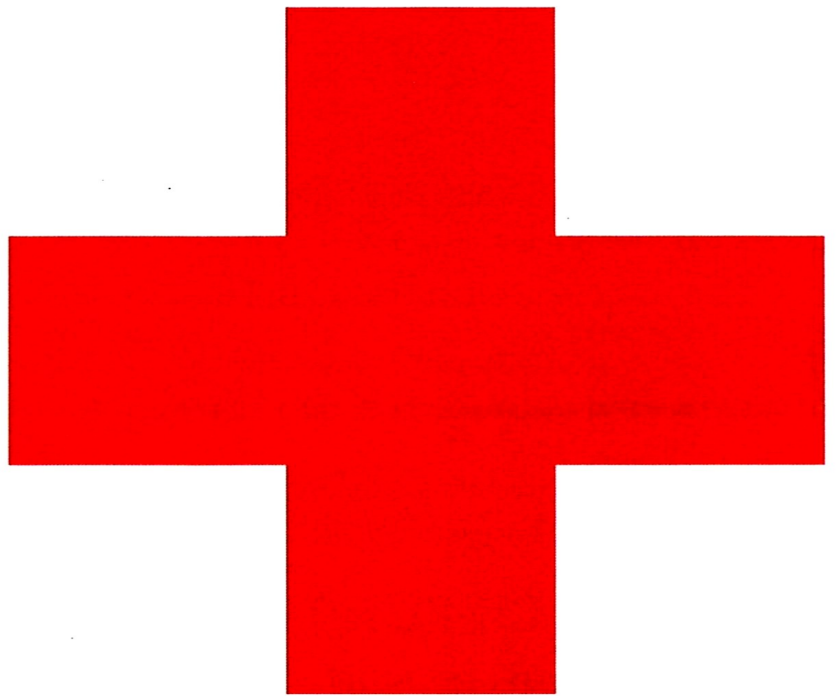

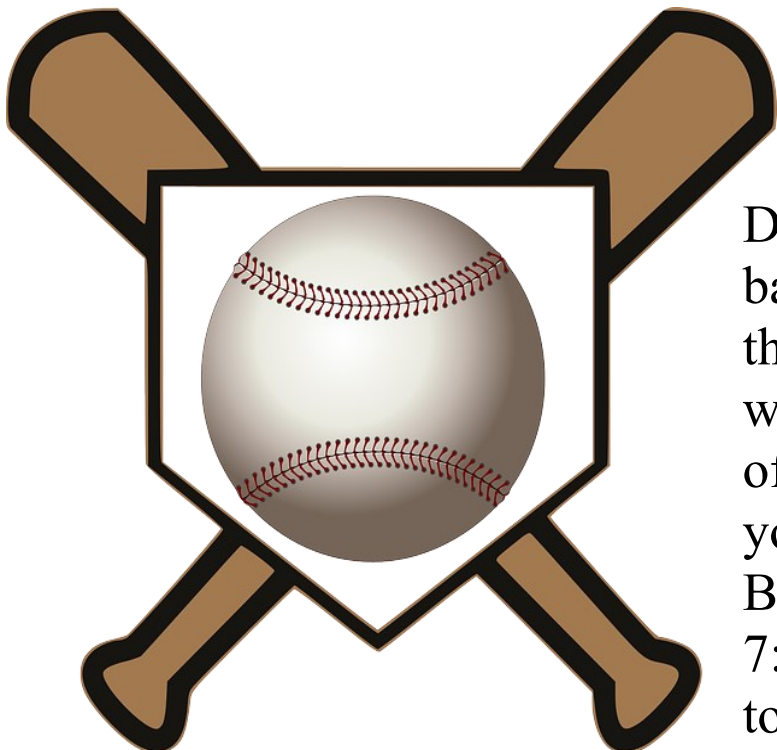
