Still, we know that people are rightly concerned about their health and larger groups of people. **So starting on Friday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> we will have a weekly Noon spoken service of Holy Communion.** It will be a shorter service and we will observe all social distancing precautions. If you are unable to attend or concerned about the larger Sunday Service, please come on Friday!

We have also begun “live-streaming” the Sunday service. The service is available on the Friends of St. James Facebook page at 10:30am on Sundays. Just let me know you would like Holy Communion and I will be ready after the service to give you communion as you drive between the church and the cemetery, stopping at the kitchen door. Or, a family member or friend may bring it to you after the service on Sunday, or call and ask me when would be convenient for me to bring it to you – appropriately masked and socially distant!


