"Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29)

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Every Sunday when the pastor has finished consecrating the Bread and Wine of Holy Communion, when we have said the Lord's Prayer and the bread has been broken, the Music Director leads the congregation in singing the Agnus Dei ("Lamb of God") hymn. "Lamb of God, you take away the sin of the world, have mercy on us...grant us peace." The hymn comes directly from the Gospel of John. These are John the Baptist's words when he saw Jesus approaching him for Baptism. In Holy Communion we recognize that this Bread and Wine is now also the Body and Blood of Jesus and like John we recognize him as the one who takes away our sin. The Sunday liturgy is full of quotes from Scripture. We use them so much, they become a part of who we are. This why we use a liturgy regularly. We want to know, deep in our bones, who Jesus is so that we never forget that he is "the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world."

This is the second week that we will read of the Baptism of Jesus, this time from John's gospel. Baptism marks the start of Jesus' ministry; baptism marks the beginning of our ministries, too. Claimed by God, we serve. Come this week and think about how you are living out God's commissioning of you in your baptism.




If you have a function and food is also involved Please remove ALL Trash and place in the dumpster after your event.
